
Salt Lake City | National and Local Historic Districts





Salt Lake City has two types of historic districts: National Historic Districts and Local Historic Districts.

National Historic Districts are listed as resources in the National Register of Historic Places.

Local Historic Districts are designated by the City to protect and maintain the historic character of neighborhoods.

All locally-designated districts in Salt Lake City are listed on the National Register, but not all National Register districts are locally-designated.
