All Electrical Permits have a \$55 base fee, plus the total of the above chart, and a 1% Utah State Fee.

A plan review process is required for all "new" generator & EV installations. After submitting an electrical permit application through the [Citizen Access Portal](#), submit a site plan, construction plans, and installation specs to [ProjectDox](#) for plan review.
