ISSUE AT-A-GLANCE

The Administration has submitted five grant applications. In an effort to ensure that the City Council, Council staff and the public has adequate opportunity to see and comment on them, the grant application notifications will be included in the Council meeting agendas under Public Hearings. There won't be a set date since this is not a required hearing.

NOTE: Items A through D are requesting funding from Utah Dept. of Workforce Services to provide curriculum and electronics and/or computer resources for YouthCity services at Fairmont Park, Northwest Recreation Center, Central City Recreation Center, and Sorenson Unity Center. The fifth grant (Item E) relates to the development of a water conservation plan for Salt Lake City School District.)

A. Utah Dept. of Workforce Services – Support for curriculum and instructional resources for YouthCity site (Fairmont Park)
