

Documentation of Operator/Owner Choice to Opt-Out of Electronic Site Inspection Requirements (19-5-108.3) and Allow Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Oversight Inspections to be Performed On-Site.

I understand that the changes implemented in Utah Code 19-5-108.3 do not reduce or eliminate any compliance responsibilities or requirements detailed in the stormwater construction permit administered by the UPDES and mandated by the Federal Clean Water Act, under which this construction site operates.

I understand that to enable electronic, off-site, oversight inspections by the MS4, enough information must be provided through geo-located and time-stamped photos to prove conclusively that all construction stormwater permit requirements are being met.

My organization chooses at this time to continue performing traditional stormwater inspections at the construction site listed below that meet construction stormwater permit requirements, but do not provide the photos necessary for an off-site, electronic oversight inspection by the local MS4. I understand that this provides a documented reason for MS4 personnel to conduct oversight inspections on-site and that this is how the oversight inspections will be performed.

I understand that my organization can change this decision to not participate in Electronic Site Inspections by the MS4 at any time and agree to make the MS4 stormwater personnel aware of any such change so they can meet the requirements of state code. (Contact stormwaterquality@slc.gov)
