


Public Utilities - Storm Water Quality (SLCDPU-SWQ) Permitting & SWPPP Review Process




State NOI for coverage under the UPDES Construction General Permit (U-CGP) or a Low Erosivity Waiver (LEW) is submitted by Operator to the State. Regardless of whether an LEW or U-CGP coverage is obtained, the operator is required to inform the City of the intent to discharge and procure (applicable) city permits and SLCDPU-SWQ approval before land disturbance begins.

If U-CGP permitted: Full SWPPP (in compliance with the U-CGP) is Required for this Project.

If LEW: The project must adhere to LEW rules (if work extends beyond LEW period, must recalculate R-factor and if >5, then a SWPPP must be developed and City and State permits procured.

SLCDPU SWPPP and TDS Review(s) using Evaluation Form(s) City NOI* Permit Application(s) Submitted by Operator;

*If the project is planning to dewater, both a City Discharge Permit and UPDES Dewatering Permit will be required in addition to the Construction Activities Discharge Permit**, and the respective UPDES permit documents (including NOI, Dewatering Control Plan, and Authorization to Discharge under the applicabel general permit) must be attached to the SWPPP. The general permits are: UTG070000 for traditional Construction Dewatering & Hydrostatic Testing; UTG790000 for Treated Groundwater and Surface Water at contaminated sites)



SLCDPU creates permit number (PUT#) and invoices application and initial inspection fees.

Upon Payment of Fees, the permit is active but permission to begin work is not granted until a SWPPP specific Pre-Construction Meeting and Initial Inspection of installed BMPs is scheduled with stormwaterquality@slc.gov and completed

 - a. <u>NOTE</u>: If the site is >1/4 acre of disturbance, a Fugitive Dust Control Plan is required by the State and shall be included in the SWPPP
