City Council Meeting Highlights

Tuesday, June 4, 2024

FY2024-25 City Budget

The Council held the second of two scheduled City Budget public hearings this evening. The Council continued reviewing the Mayor's recommended FY25 budget and discussed proposed department budgets. Recent discussions include:

The Council also held an initial discussion intended to narrow down the list of budget items the Council is potentially interested in changing. - Authorized assistance for the <u>Fairmont Heights Senior Housing</u>
 <u>Development project</u>, which would provide ~110 new affordable senior housing units in Sugar House.
- Adopted the remainder of <u>FY2023-24 Budget Amendment No. 5</u>, which includes funding to improve traffic control and safety at the 2200 West and 2100 North Intersection.
- Reviewed and approved an Economic Development Loan Fund loan for local microbrewer Shades of Pale to help create 10 new jobs and retain 11 existing jobs.
- Interviewed and appointed Karen Ferguson to the <u>City and County</u>
 Building Conservation and Use Committee.
- Made the following board reappointments:
 - Talula Pontuti to the <u>Parks</u>, <u>Natural Lands</u>, <u>Urban Forestry</u>, <u>and Trails Advisory Board</u>.
 - Tiffini Porter to the Art Design Board.
